

Axis network video products run on Ethernet networking. They provide an easy way to capture and distribute high quality video over any kind of IP network or the Internet. The video can be stored at remote locations for convenience and security, and the information can be transported in a secured way over the IP network or Internet. Using standard PC server hardware for video recording and storage rather than proprietary equipment (such as DVRs) radically reduces management and equipment costs, particularly for larger systems where storage and servers are a significant portion of the total solution cost.

Video management software supplies the basis for video monitoring, analysis, and recording. To view several cameras at the same time, dedicated video management software is required. Axis Application Development Partners (ADPs) offer a wide range of retail applications to fit your needs.
